- Glenn Waldhuter and Graham Goode gave an update of their committee activities
- 5. Sergeant at Arms David held a lucrative fines session.
- 6. Guest Speaker John Hardy talked to us about Angel Flight. It commenced in 1998. It helps with the tyranny of distance for country people by providing air transport for medical reasons, not emergencies in particular. It raises money and elicits support to pay for flights for patients and their families who live far away from medical services. Every mission is unique, and not necessarily to and from the outback just distance from major hospitals. Pilots and drivers volunteer. Passengers are met at airports to be transported to medical care. Angel Flight does not own planes or cars, but relies on volunteers. It has flown 25,000 missions since 2003. 5,000 pilots Australia wide work for free for Angel Flight. BP donates a small fuel allowance. Contact is made through local doctors and nurses.
