Broken Hill in April. - Group 9 meeting; 3 Clare members went. Guest Speaker Ron Kandelaars was an interesting and enthusiastic representative for SA tourism. - Last meeting with the DG – didn't get through all the items on the agenda. - Lots of group projects and events planned. - Request from John Rowe – can we host a Vocational Training Team from the Phillipines. The focus will be Rural Health (Doctors, nurses, paramedics) Clare Medical Centre is interested in taking part. Ian Howlett received a request from RFDS for use of some of our equipment. - A show of hands was asked for to determine who receives the Rotary magazine. Those who don't get it (either email or hard copy) to see Ian after meeting. - A letter to all clubs asking for EOLs for grants; not one Rotary Club responded. Lions did it 2 years ago and won \$2,5000 (Premier's Award) Barrie Smith Rotary Spot – had a visit from one of the American Rotary Clubs that he has visited in the past. He reminded us that Rotary is worldwide. Guest Speaker Yadrakar Licitar (Yad) - Has been with United Country Care SA for 12 years. - Works with families in need due to domestic violence and homelessness. - Also works in homes supporting families. - She started off with troubles in her own life, which pushed her to study for a qualification. - The agency has 7 local workers. - They service clients in Clare, Burra, Tarlee, Port Wakefield and Peterborough. - Provide foster care support and encourage resilient families. - Workers are very stretched and overworked, but with great support from organisation .Main cause of homelessness is family breakdown and DV. - Dealing with 3rd generation poor parenting: parents too young, drug addicted or mentally ill. - Try to keep families together if possible. - Funded by State and Federal governments and bequests. - The situation is not all dire – they do have lots of wins. - Thanks Yad, for a strong and informative address. Glenn Waldhuter informed that Gawler Club will support our 5 NYSF students to the tune of \$3,000. J Pulford gave brief report on Town Hall Committee. Will purchase new round tables to boost use of Town Hall for wedding receptions etc. H Weber encouraged us all to support wine sales. PP Stephen and Pres Josie inducted Bronwyn Willis as a Rotary Member. A warm welcome Bronwyn.
