- Highlight for the year was the completion of the new Salvation Army building in Gawler called Riverside Salvation
- Official opening on 6Oct18
- Building comprises main worship area, administration, reception, a board room, play area, cafe, small meeting room, and storage rooms
- Seating for 300 people
- Doors open up to main carpark at the rear
- At the rear there is a bush garden with over 3000 trees and shrubs plus seating
- Cafe is run by volunteers
- There are a couple of good baristas
- Cafe has indoor and outdoor seating linked to the playground
- There are plans for provision of meals
- Process is underway for a grant to purchase a community bus
- There are community support services including a financial counsellor
- A lady from the church is doing hair cuts for free each week
- Men's breakfast every six weeks
- Autism SA linked with Salvos—sensory room being developed
- Parents Next Program
- Program to assist people to get back into the workforce
- What's the Buzz—16 week program for social skill development for 7-12 year olds
