Subject: Gawler Sport and Community Centre - Step 1 for Easing COVID-19 restrictions

Dear Community User Group,

We hope that you and the members of your group have been staying safe during the COVID-19 pandemic. As many of you would be aware, the Federal and State directives have been announced and the SA Roadmap for easing COVID-19 restrictions has been introduced (as attached). After reviewing this new information, we are happy to announce that the Gawler Sport and Community Centre will reopen on Monday 18 May 2020.

However, due to the restrictions on the number of patrons in the facility there is a maximum of 10 patrons allowed in the centre at any one time (excluding council staff). Use of the facility will be by predetermined booking times only and all groups will be asked to be flexible in regard to the time and day of their booking. To maintain stringent cleaning processes we will be reviewing the room allocation for all bookings and to ensure that Entry and Exits from the facility can be monitored. We will be in contact with you to determine if your group is seeking to return under these conditions and also if you have an alternative preference in regard to time/day of booking. This may assist us if we have more than one group wishing to return at the same time.

A number of other factors are to be considered in determining which of our groups would like to return to the centre that are able to comply with the restrictions in place.

We are also committed to ensure the facility is operated in a safe and sustainable. Our conditions of entry have been updated to reflect this and include:

- The number of people in the facility is restricted to a maximum of 10 patrons (excluding council staff).

- No sporting activities or physical training to occur inside the facility.

- DO NOT attend the Gawler Sport & Community Centre if you or anyone in your group has any symptoms of cold or flu.

- Observe and implement social distancing 1.5 metres at all times.

- Encourage good hygiene and washing of hands or use sanitiser provided before entering and exiting the Centre.

- Maintain appropriate personal hygiene practices (especially covering coughs and sneezes).

- No kiosk facilities will be available or seating outside of the room used for your activity.

- Please note that there will be no access to showers.

We look forward to working with your group to returning to the facility, whether that be as part of Step 1 or at a later date as further restrictions are eased.
