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LOCAL VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS PROTECTING OUR COMMUNITY

The Country Fire Service Foundation's purpose is to provide **immediate financial support** to CFS volunteer firefighters and their families in the event of death, injury or loss of property while engaging in their community service.

In South Australia we are blessed that over 14,500 CFS volunteer firefighters make themselves available in our communities, at no cost, to deal with fires, floods, chemical spills and road crashes. Some of these events are catastrophic and many quite tragic.

The CFS volunteer firefighters are highly trained and are on call 24/7, 365 days of the year, ready to protect life, property and our communities at times of great danger.

Located in 425 brigades within the SA community, each volunteer commits over 1,000 hours each year and in total, the CFS responds to approximately **20,000 incidents annually**.

The CFS Foundation is an independent, not-for-profit organisation which exists solely to **support the volunteers** and their families in times of need – and this support is urgently required when a CFS volunteer firefighter is injured or killed in the line of duty.
