We met at the Kilikanoon winery site, where chief winemaker, Peter Warr gave us a tour of the facility. Harvest has just come to an end. 2019 not a good year for quantity, but the quality is pleasingly high. At picking, the grapes are augered into a de-stemmer. Each pressing of the grapes gives a different quality. Quite a lot of hand picking of the older vines is still done at Kilikanoon.. Picking by machine costs \$100 per tonne, while hand picking costs \$500 – 600. Large 10 tonne fermenters. Fermentation is about the speed of yeast and temperature. 40 degrees gives a very ordinary wine – colder fermentation means better results. Fermentation is inspected vigilantly. Their Attunga wine must be made in the one French oak barrel. These grapes are foot pressed. They come from vines 170 years old. We were offered tastings of a week old Riesling – not yet filtered. Grape sugar is added. Sulphur is used to kill yeast and bacteria. The alcohol level comes from grape sugar, but the flavour comes from the skins. Red wine grapes give white juice – the skins give the colour. French oak barrels are very expensive and have a limited life (8 to 10 years). We learnt a lot of new facts about what we drink. Thanks Peter for a very informative talk.

We then adjourned to the Auburn Hotel for dinner.

Pres Josie asked for someone to accompany her to the “Applying for Grants” session from 10 to 4 on Sat May 4th.

David Dunstan spoke briefly about his recent “Silos” trip with Gary Honeychurch As part of the Rotary Motorcycle Club through SA and Victoria.
