Guest Speaker: Shena Osman—Kickstart for Kids

- KickStart For Kids is a not-for-profit organisation with 3 full time employees that helps disadvantaged school children in South Australia achieve positive educational outcomes and increased self-esteem through school breakfast and lunch programs, mentoring programs and Camp KickStart school holiday care program.
- Over 100 KickStart for Kids mentors are currently volunteering in schools around Adelaide.
- The mentors spend an hour a week with a child who is at risk of disengaging from the educational system, or who needs a significant adult in their lives.
- Mentors work with kids during the school term to nurture and develop their self-esteem, getting to know them and encouraging them to work towards a better life for themselves.
- All mentors require a DCSI police check and Report of Abuse and Neglect training prior to commencing in a school.
- KickStart for Kids currently serves around 50,000 breakfasts per week in 350 SA schools. The schools are spread widely across South Australia in the North, West, South and several regional areas.
- As children who come to school without having breakfast generally also don't have lunch to eat, volunteers also make 10,000 cheese and vegemite sandwiches each week.
