- Foundation formed 20 years ago
- The objective was to provide support to people not supported by other services to access needed treatment, support or equipment
- Set up with \$50
- Rotary Club of Gawler, Rotary Club of Gawler Light and the GAWler Lions Club support the Foundation
- Trustees empowered to use discretion in using funds to assist people in need
- Gawler Club put in \$10 000 during the early stages and later Gawler Light set up fund raising opportunities
- Not required to do lengthy application. Simple questions and evidence to apply
- Applicants asked to express needs in own words
- Requests can be received by more than one club but having one committee avoids double dipping
- District conference 2004 profit boosted funds
- Funds maintained by donations from the 3 clubs
- NDIS has led to decrease in applications but still support needed by various applicants
- Privacy paramount
- Area of support extends from Smithfield to McDonald Pk, Freeling, Sheoak Log, One Tree Hill
