Gala To Cure Type 1 Diabetes - Eliza's 4000km Walk for JDR

Starting on April 1st 2019 Eliza Bartlett, aged 26 years of age will be walking 4000km from Italy to Scotland (crossing Switzerland, France, and England). Eliza was diagnosed with Juvenile or type 1 diabetes at age 9.

"In May 2001 my life changed forever when I was diagnosed with T1D. Since that day I have been determined to do my part, to ensure a cure is found for future generations. For this reason I have decided to walk approx. 4000km from Italy to Scotland to raise money and awareness for T1D. I am funding the trip myself to ensure all the money I raise will be going direct to JDRF. I hope to raise more than \$100,000 towards this great cause"

As part of my fundraising efforts I am hosting a gala dinner – Eliza's Walk for JDRF."


