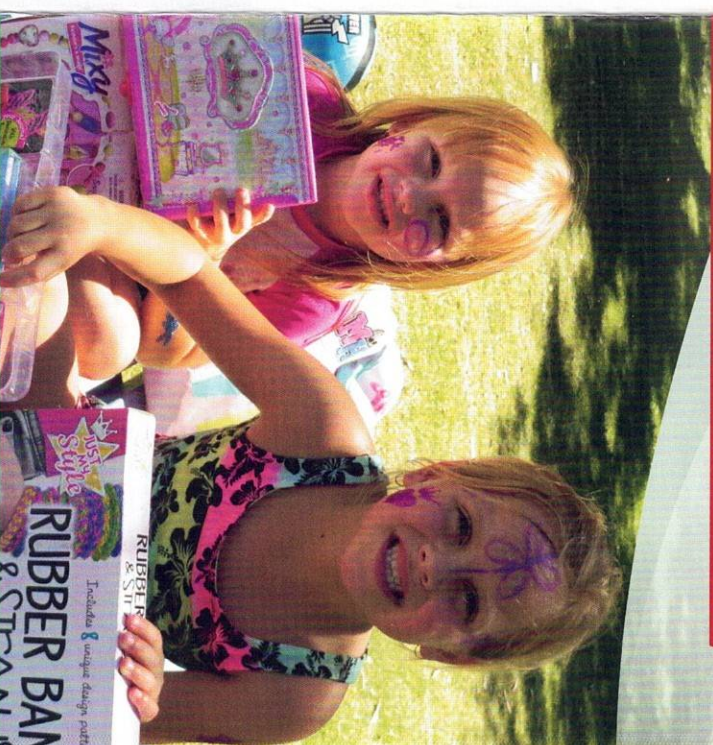

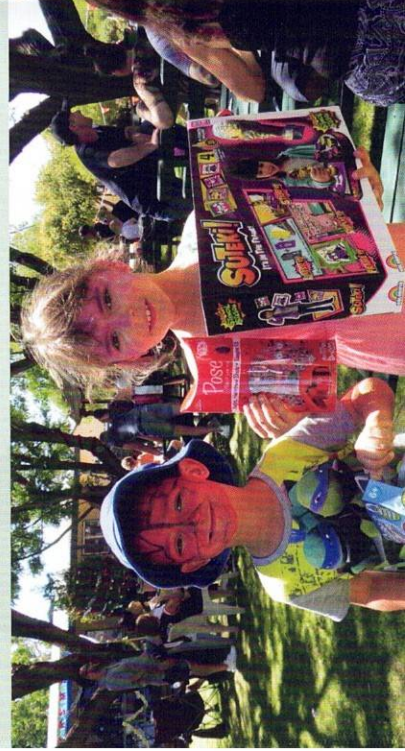
BRINGING JOY

“My daughters love the presents they have received. It means a lot to them knowing their father (me) gives them Christmas presents.”



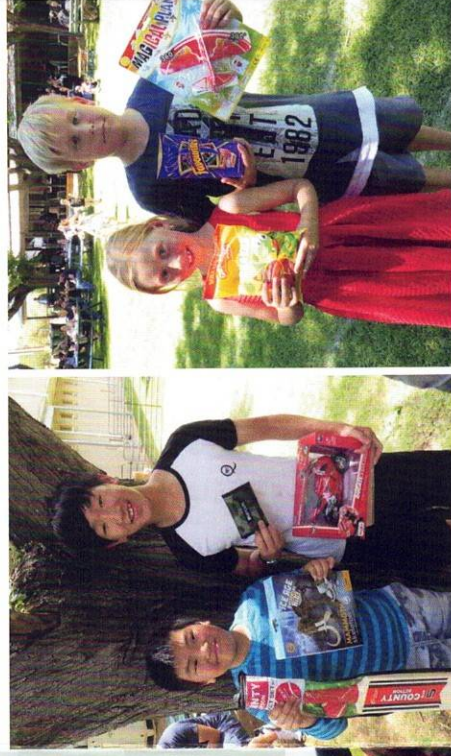
HOW IT WORKS
