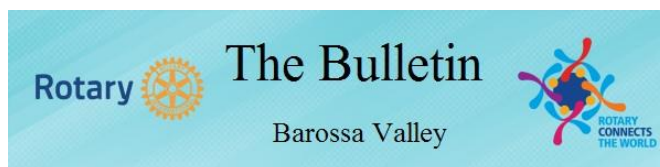

The blind lady replied, 'No thanks, but maybe Max would like to stretch his legs.'

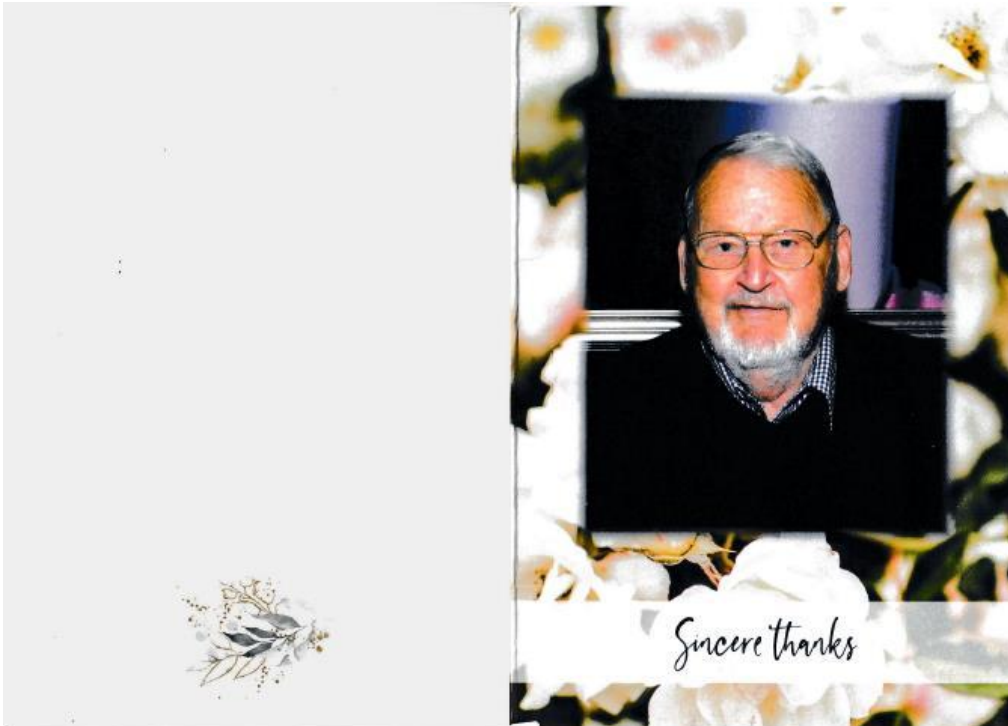
Picture this:

Coronavirus Bulletin Board

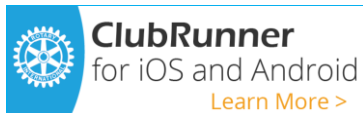
