GUEST SPEAKER: Jenny Dorsett on overseas adoption

Jenny & her husband Peter were married in 1974. After being unable to get pregnant using IVF in 1980's & because of low numbers of children for adoption in Australia , they decided to look into overseas adoption.

They chose South Korea as their adoption system was well organised, with government approval. They chose to adopt a girl between 4 & 6 months. After an interview with a social worker and an 8 month wait their file was approved. After another 4 month wait, the South Korean Government approved their application and they made arrangements to travel.

Their little girl was four & a half months old. Eventually they adopted a second little girl. They managed to change medicare ruling that their first child was an illegal alien. They count themselves fortunate that their experience has been a positive one, with little prejudice. Their daughters are now 34 & 32 and they have 6 grandchildren and many South Korean friends.




The decision to keep singing the National Anthem & Song of Australia was passed by majority vote.
