Community Voices partners not-for-profit organisations with film making students from University to produce either a five-minute documentary or a 30-second online video ad volunteer recruitment and community education.

Applications are now open for the 2020 Community Voices Program.

The key dates are:

Applications close 18 December 2019

- **Applications assessed by the selection panel** January 2020

Applicants notified February 2020

Online video advertisement production and delivery March - June 2020

Documentary production and delivery July - November 2020
