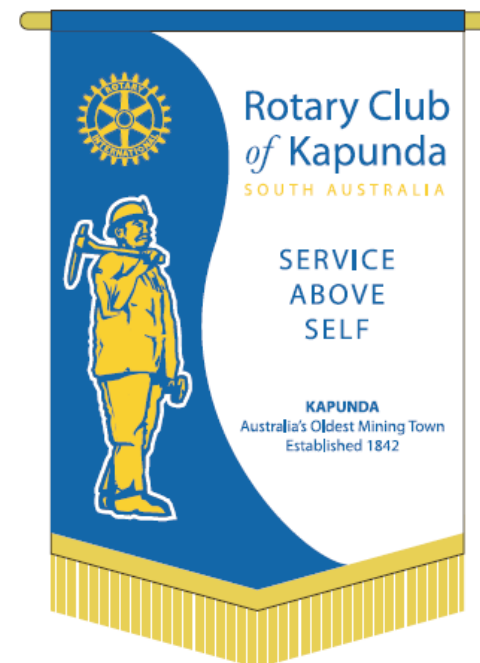

David then introduced Kristen Masters as guest speaker for the evening:



- Great highlight for students to have a real audience to prepare a meal for
- KHS has reached capacity over recent years
- State gov commitment to contribute \$12M for building renewal/replacement
- Year 7 students to be integrated into high schools from primary
- Stage one - 4-5 new flexible classrooms in/around PE area
- Stage two - replacement of 60s era transportable classrooms
- Projection that KHS will top 800 students within 10 years
- Hopefully building works will commence late next year
- WA & Qld have recently moved year 7s to high schools
- Strong focus on student wellbeing - 47% sleep with smartphones, 40% have sleeping problems, 15-24 year olds exhibiting alarming increase in self harm
- Holding students in maths & science subjects a real challenge
- KHS is really appreciative of Rotary Kapunda's continued support such as RYDA & Defibrillator projects.
