FAMILIES ARE RUNNING OUT OF PLACES TO GO

Nearly 1 million people have been forced to flee their homes in Syria since December. This is the largest exodus of civilians since the violence started 9 years ago.

As the threat of military action from the Turkish government looms over Idlib, more families are preparing to leave their homes in search of safety.

Right now, families in Syria desperately need your help. In some parts of the country, there's snow on the ground and items like thermal blankets could **save lives**.
