12. **Safe Water Saves Lives** provides composting toilets to keep rivers clean.
13. **Rotary Australia Benevolent Society** – eg Purple House in Alice Springs, dialysis clinics.
14. **Rotary Developed Countries Disaster Fund** is mainly for disaster relief eg hurricanes.
15. **Rotary/Channel 9/Farmers Federation** raised \$10.1 million for drought relief.
