- July 2017 dental chairs collected
- Biomedical goods
- Containers shipped or ready to go overseas
- Dealt with 65 interested parties & of those 28 remained on list
- Most destinations completed
- Loading done primarily at RAH and DIK
- Biomedical equipment 22000 items requested but 600 items available
- Non-biomedical 20000 items requested but not enough for all
- Consumables and other stuff 103 pallets collected
- Nominal value \$7,000,000
- Replacement value eg purchase price \$12 13 million
- Bucket list to go to see container arriving overseas.
 Went to Fiji and assisted with unloading
- Tour of hospital and met staff
- Fijians have very high % diabetes and often do not seek qualified medical treatment until seriously ill and often needing amputation
- Description of hospital conditions
- Sight seeing/tourist experience boat trip, dance, village, housing etc
- Friendly people
- Question asked about red tape and corruption in some countries
