

To the Manager/Owner, all Port Adelaide and Semaphore businesses... Have you heard of the Port Adelaide & Semaphore Cruise Ship Shuttle Bus? This is a shuttle bus service specifically tailored to bring national and international visitors arriving at Outer Harbour on Cruise Ships to Port Adelaide & Semaphore.

The specific intention of the shuttle bus service is to divert these visitors from heading off elsewhere in Adelaide and bringing them to the local area to take in our history...& spend their holiday \$\$dollars\$\$ here! The North West Business Alliance have been operating the Hop On Hop Off Shuttle Bus service for 3 years now, and are happy to report the passenger numbers visiting the local area have increased year on year (with over <u>1300</u>passengers staying and shopping/sightseeing locally last season). With the help of local volunteers and businesses, passengers are currently intercepted at Outer Harbour on their way to the train station and provided information around what the Port and Semaphore has to offer. Whilst, as the increase in passenger numbers indicate, the service has been building each year, we need the support of local businesses to help encourage passengers to stay local.

We are passionate locals wanting to support local businesses – but we can't do it alone!
